

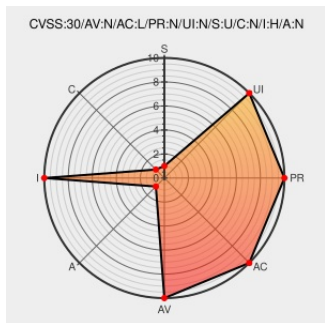

Certain versions of [Syncthing](#) from [Syncthing](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Syncthing version 0.14.33 and older is vulnerable to symlink traversal resulting in arbitrary file overwrite
