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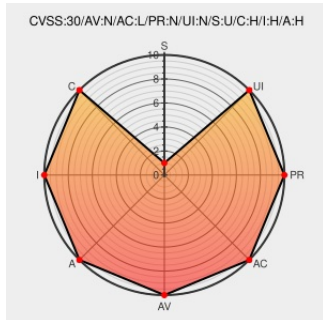

Vulnerability in wordpress plugin surveys v1.01.8, The code in individual_responses.php does not sanitize the survey_id variable before placing it inside of an SQL query.
