Certain versions of [Gallery-transformation](#) from [Angrybyte](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Vulnerability in wordpress plugin wordpress-gallery-transformation v1.0, SQL injection is in ./wordpress-gallery-transformation/gallery.php via \$jplic parameter being unsanitized before being passed into an SQL query.

CVE-2017-1002028 has been assigned by larry0@me.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
