Description	Vulnerability in the Oracle Outside In Technology component of Oracle Fusion Middleware (subcomponent: Outside In Filter for PDF) is present in the following Oracle Fusion Middleware versions: 11.1.1.7.0 to 11.1.1.7.0. The vulnerability allows a remote attacker to execute arbitrary code on the target system. The vulnerability is due to a buffer overflow in the PDF rendering engine. An attacker who has access to a PDF file can exploit this vulnerability by sending a specially crafted PDF file to the target system. The attacker can then execute arbitrary code on the target system, which can result in the disclosure of sensitive information or the compromise of the system. Oracle has released a patch for this vulnerability in the form of a Critical Patch Update (CPE) for Oracle Fusion Middleware. Users are advised to apply the patch as soon as possible to mitigate the risk of exploitation.
