Certain versions of [Freebsd](#) from [Freebsd](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In FreeBSD before 11.2-RELEASE, a stack guard-page is available but is disabled by default. This results in the possibility a poorly written process could be cause a stack overflow.

CVE-2017-1083 has been assigned by secteam@freebsd.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
