

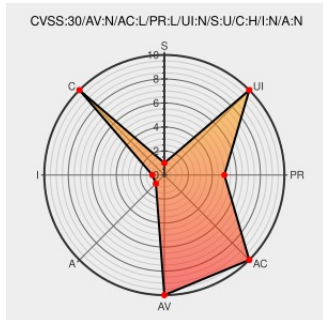

Certain versions of [Heinekingmedia](#) from [Stashcat](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in heinekingmedia StashCat through 1.7.5 for Android. The login credentials are written into a log file on the device. Hence, an attacker with access to the logs can read them.

CVE-2017-11134 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
