Certain versions of [Glpi](#) from [Glpi-project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

GLPI before 9.1.5.1 has SQL Injection in the \$crit variable in inc/computer_softwareversion.class.php, exploitable via ajax/common.tabs.php.

CVE-2017-11474 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
