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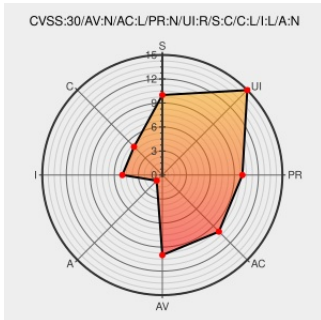

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Certain versions of [Rspamd](#) from [Rspamd Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

interface/js/app/history.js in WebUI in Rspamd before 1.6.3 allows XSS via the Subject and Message-Id headers, which are mishandled in the history page.

CVE-2017-11737 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
