Description	In MODX Revolution 2.5.7, the "key" and "name" parameters in the System Settings module are vulnerable to XSS. A malicious user can inject arbitrary HTML or JavaScript into the page. This can be used to steal sensitive information, deface the website, or perform other malicious actions.
