

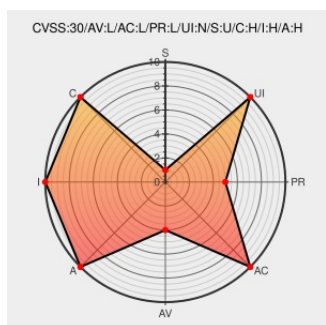

Certain versions of [Bigfix Platform](#) from [Ibm](#) contain the following vulnerability:

IBM BigFix Platform 9.5 - 9.5.9 stores user credentials in plain in clear text which can be read by a local user. IBM X-Force ID: 123910.

CVE-2017-1231 has been assigned by [psirt@us.ibm.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
