Certain versions of [Binutils](#) from [Gnu](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The `read_symbol_stabs_debugging_info` function in `rddb.c` in GNU Binutils 2.29 and earlier allows remote attackers to cause an out of bounds heap read via a crafted binary file.

CVE-2017-12456 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
