

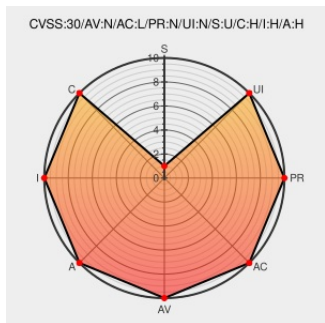

Certain versions of [Dolibarr](#) from [Dolibarr](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerability in admin/menus/edit.php in Dolibarr ERP/CRM version 6.0.0 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the menuId parameter.

CVE-2017-14238 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
