Certain versions of [Stdu Viewer](#) from [Stdutility](#) contain the following vulnerability:

STDU Viewer 1.6.375 allows attackers to cause a denial of service or possibly have unspecified other impact via a crafted .xps file, related to "Data from Faulting Address controls Branch Selection starting at STDUXPSFile!DllUnregisterServer+0x00000000000005bd2."

CVE-2017-14560 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
