

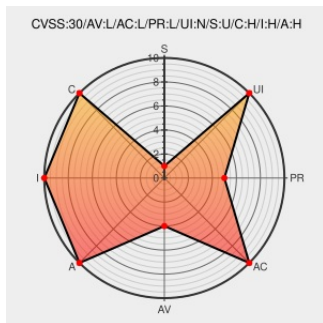


# CVE-2017-14563

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## CVE-2017-14563

Certain versions of [Stdu Viewer](#) from [Stdutility](#) contain the following vulnerability:

STDU Viewer 1.6.375 allows attackers to execute arbitrary code or cause a denial of service via a crafted .xps file, related to a "Read Access Violation on Block Data Move starting at STDUXPSFile!DllUnregisterServer+0x00000000000005311."

CVE-2017-14563 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
