Certain versions of [E-sic](#) from [Softwarepublico](#) contain the following vulnerability:

E-Sic 1.0 allows SQL injection via the q parameter to `esiclivre/restrito/inc/lkpcep.php` (aka the search private area).

CVE-2017-15373 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
