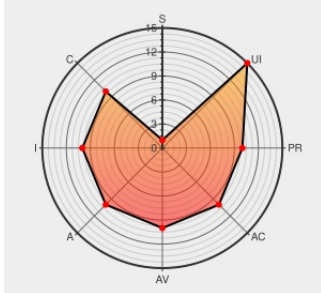

Certain versions of [Chrome](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A stack buffer overflow in V8 in Google Chrome prior to 62.0.3202.75 allowed a remote attacker to perform an out of bounds memory read via a crafted HTML page.

CVE-2017-15406 has been assigned by [Google](#) security@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
