

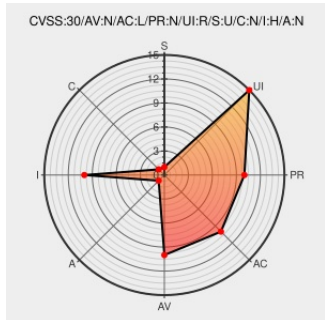

Certain versions of [Proget](#) from [Inedo](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Inedo ProGet before 5.0 Beta5 has CSRF, allowing an attacker to change advanced settings.

CVE-2017-15608 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
