

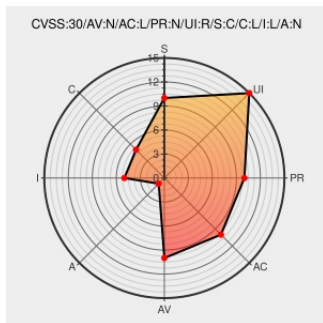

Certain versions of [Php Melody](#) from [Phpsugar](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In PHPSUGAR PHP Melody before 2.7.3, page_manager.php has XSS via the page_title parameter.
