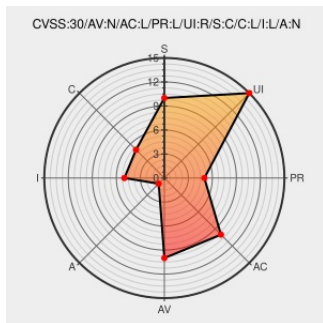

In phpMyFAQ before 2.9.9, there is Stored Cross-site Scripting (XSS) via an HTML attachment.

CVE-2017-15727 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
