Certain versions of [No-case](#) from [No-case Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The no-case module is vulnerable to regular expression denial of service. When malicious untrusted user input is passed into no-case it can block the event loop causing a denial of service condition.

CVE-2017-16099 has been assigned by [h1](#) support@hackerone.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
