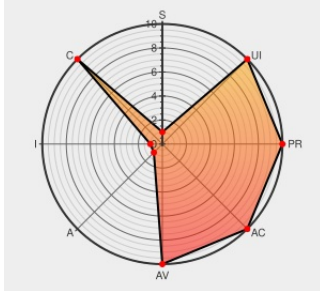

Certain versions of [Exxxxxxxxxxxx](#) from [Exxxxxxxxxxxx Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

xxxxxxxxxxx is an Http eX Frame Google Style JavaScript Guide. xxxxxxxxxxxxxx is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url. Accessible files are restricted to those with a file extension. Files with no extension such as /etc/passwd throw an error.

CVE-2017-16130 has been assigned by [h1 support@hackerone.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
