

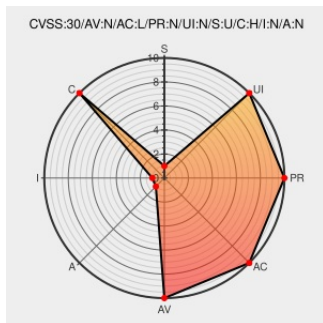

Certain versions of [Serverzyy](#) from [Serverzyy Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

serverzyy is a static file server. serverzyy is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url.

CVE-2017-16135 has been assigned by [HackerOne](#) support@hackerone.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
