Certain versions of [Sspa](#) from [Sspa Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

sspa is a server dedicated to single-page apps. sspa is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url.

CVE-2017-16145 has been assigned by [h1](#) support@hackerone.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
