Certain versions of [Earlybird](#) from [Earlybird Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

earlybird is a web server module for early development. earlybird is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url.

CVE-2017-16154 has been assigned by [h1 support@hackerone.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
