

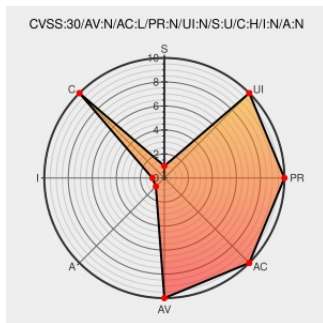

Certain versions of [Censorify.tanisjr](#) from [Censorify.tanisjr Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

censorify.tanisjr is a simple web server and API RESTful service. censorify.tanisjr is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url.

CVE-2017-16157 has been assigned by support@hackerone.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
