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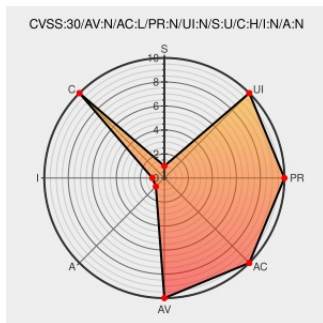

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Certain versions of [Wffserve](#) from [Wffserve Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

wffserve is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url.

CVE-2017-16168 has been assigned by [h1 support@hackerone.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
