

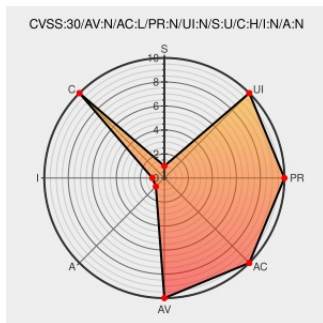

Certain versions of [Getcityapi.yoehoehe](#) from [Getcityapi.yoehoehe Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

getcityapi.yoehoehe is a web server. getcityapi.yoehoehe is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url.

CVE-2017-16192 has been assigned by [HackerOne](#) support@hackerone.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
