Certain versions of [Jn Jj Server](#) from [Jn Jj Server Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

jn_jj_server is a static file server. jn_jj_server is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url.

CVE-2017-16210 has been assigned by [h1 support@hackerone.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
