

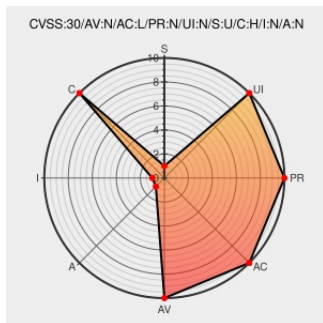

Certain versions of [Fbr-client](#) from [Webrtc-experiment](#) contain the following vulnerability:

fbr-client sends files through sockets via socket.io and webRTC. fbr-client is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url.

CVE-2017-16217 has been assigned by support@hackerone.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
