Certain versions of **Yttivy** from **Yttivy Project** contain the following vulnerability:

yttivy is a static file server. yttivy is vulnerable to a directory traversal issue, giving an attacker access to the filesystem by placing "../" in the url.

CVE-2017-16219 has been assigned by **h1** support@hackerone.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
