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Certain versions of [Symphony](#) from [Symphony Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

b3log Symphony (aka Sym) 2.2.0 allows an XSS attack by sending a private letter with a certain /article URI, and a second private letter with a modified title.

CVE-2017-16956 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
