

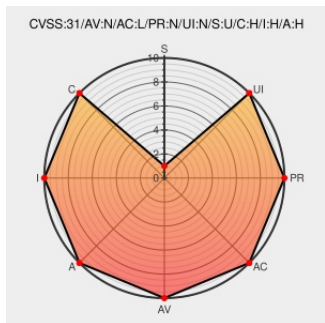

FS Monster Clone 1.0 has SQL Injection via the Employer_Details.php id parameter.
