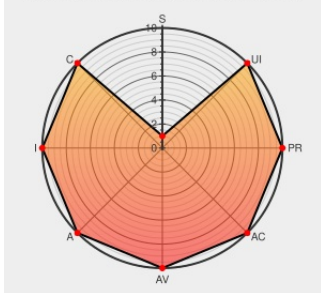

Beauty Parlour Booking Script 1.0 has SQL Injection via the /list gender or city parameter.
