

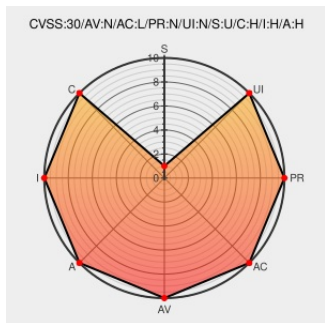

Child Care Script 1.0 has SQL Injection via the /list city parameter.
