

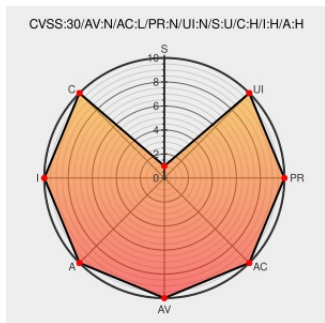

Certain versions of [Secure E-commerce Script](#) from [Secure E-commerce Script Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Secure E-commerce Script 2.0.1 has SQL Injection via the category.php searchmain or searchcat parameter, or the single_detail.php sid parameter.

CVE-2017-17629 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
