

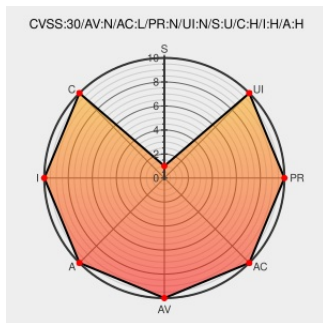

DedeCMS through 5.7 has SQL Injection via the logo parameter to plus/flink_add.php.

CVE-2017-17730 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
