

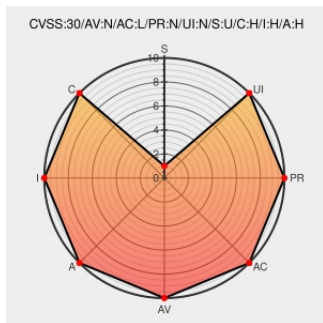

Certain versions of [Jbuilder](#) from [Jbuilder](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The JBuilder extension 1.4.1 for Joomla! has SQL Injection via the appid parameter in an entriesssearch action.

CVE-2017-17870 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
