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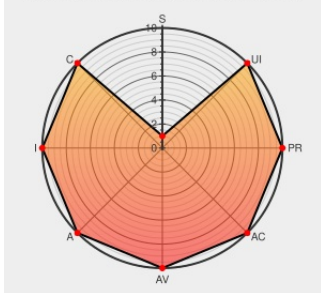

The JEXTN FAQ Pro extension 4.0.0 for Joomla! has SQL Injection via the id parameter in a view=category action.
