

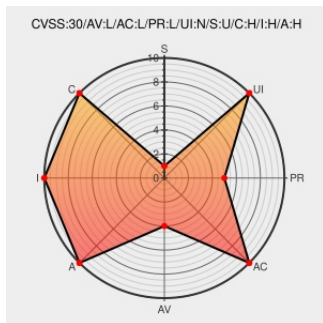

Certain versions of [Android](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A crafted binder request can cause an arbitrary unmap in MediaServer in all Android releases from CAF (Android for MSM, Firefox OS for MSM, QRD Android) using the Linux Kernel.

CVE-2017-18154 has been assigned by [Q](#) product-security@qualcomm.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
