

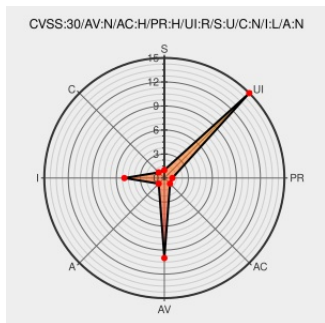

Certain versions of [Cpanel](#) from [Cpanel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

cPanel before 68.0.15 allows collisions because PostgreSQL databases can be assigned to multiple accounts (SEC-325).
