

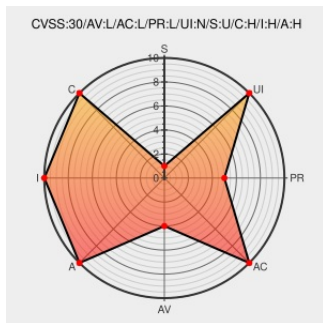

Certain versions of [Linux Kernel](#) from [Linux](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in net/rds/af_rds.c in the Linux kernel before 4.11. There is an out of bounds write and read in the function rds_recv_track_latency.

CVE-2017-18552 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
