

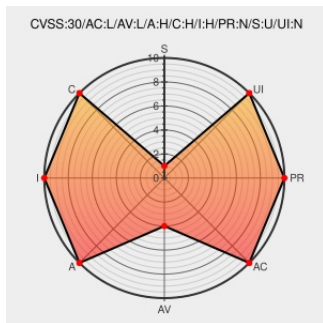

Certain versions of **D7000** from **Netgear** contain the following vulnerability:

Certain NETGEAR devices are affected by disclosure of administrative credentials. This affects R6700v2 before 1.1.0.38, R6800 before 1.1.0.38, and D7000 before 1.0.1.50.

CVE-2017-18844 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
