

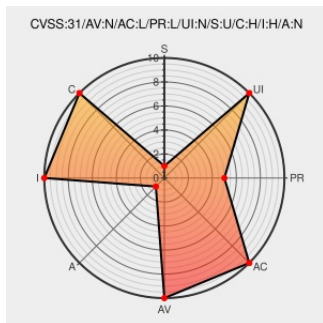

Certain versions of [Mattermost Server](#) from [Mattermost](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in Mattermost Server before 4.0.0, 3.10.2, and 3.9.2, when Single Sign-On OAuth2 is used. An attacker could claim somebody else's account.

CVE-2017-18906 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
