

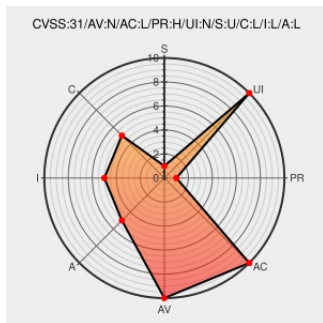

Certain versions of [Phplist](#) from [Phplist](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability was found in PHPList 3.2.6. It has been classified as critical. Affected is an unknown function of the file /lists/admin/ of the component Sending Campaign. The manipulation leads to sql injection. It is possible to launch the attack remotely. The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. Upgrading to version 3.3.1 is able to address this issue. It is recommended to upgrade the affected component.

CVE-2017-20030 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
