

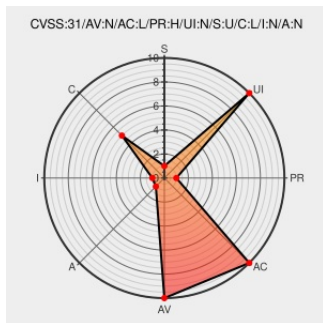

Certain versions of [Phplist](#) from [Phplist](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability was found in PHPList 3.2.6. It has been declared as problematic. Affected by this vulnerability is an unknown functionality. The manipulation of the argument sortby with the input password leads to information disclosure. The attack can be launched remotely. The exploit has been disclosed to the public and may be used. Upgrading

to version 3.3.1 is able to address this issue. It is recommended to upgrade the affected component.

CVE-2017-20031 has been assigned by [cna@vuldb.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **LOW** severity.
