

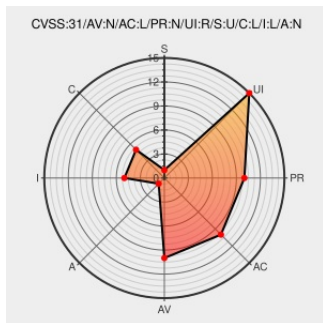

Certain versions of [Uc Browser](#) from [Ucweb](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability was found in Ucweb UC Browser 11.2.5.932. It has been classified as critical. Affected is an unknown function of the component HTML Handler. The manipulation of the argument title leads to improper restriction of rendered ui layers (URL). It is possible to launch the attack remotely. The exploit has been disclosed to the

public and may be used.

CVE-2017-20041 has been assigned by cna@vuldb.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
