

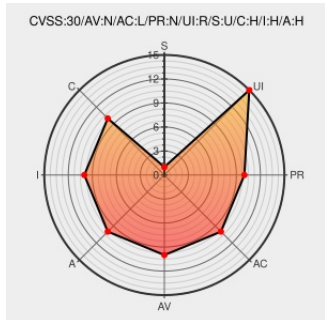

Certain versions of [Hoozin Viewer](#) from [I.con Corporation](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Buffer overflow in Hoozin Viewer 2, 3, 4.1.5.15 and earlier, 5.1.2.13 and earlier, and 6.0.3.09 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via specially crafted webpage.

CVE-2017-2155 has been assigned by [vultures@jpcert.or.jp](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
