

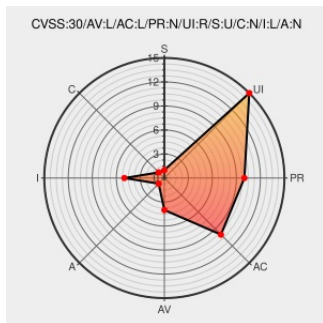

Certain versions of [Lhaplus](#) from [Lhaplus Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Improper verification when expanding ZIP64 archives in Lhaplus versions 1.73 and earlier may lead to unintended contents to be extracted from a specially crafted ZIP64 archive.

CVE-2017-2158 has been assigned by [vultures@jpcert.or.jp](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **LOW** severity.
