

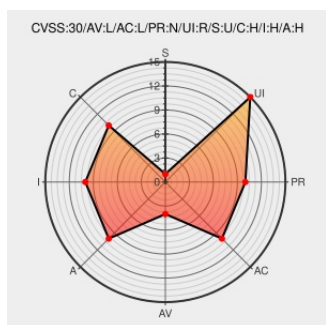

Certain versions of [Patchjgd](#) from [Gsi](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Untrusted search path vulnerability in PatchJGD (Hyoko) (PatchJGDh101.EXE) ver. 1.0.1 allows an attacker to gain privileges via a Trojan horse DLL in an unspecified directory.

CVE-2017-2211 has been assigned by [vultures@jpcert.or.jp](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
