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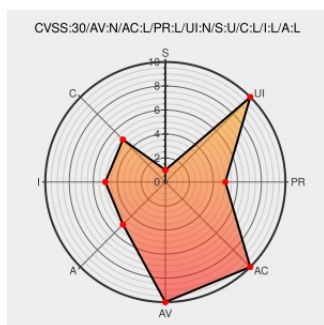

Certain versions of **Mac Os X** from **Apple** contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerability in the AssetView for MacOS Ver.9.2.0 and earlier versions allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via "File Transfer Web Service".

CVE-2017-2241 has been assigned by vultures@jpcert.or.jp to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
